

## **Dual-Time-Setting – Model**

SaoPaolo/Copacabana/Macau/Damascus/ Hamburg/Oman/Buenos Aires

First, make sure that both dials run in sync.

To do this, set the hands to a full hour. If the hour hand of the DualTime is between two full hours, then turn the hands counterclockwise until the minute hands point to 10 minutes. Then move the hands clockwise to the next full hour.

Now the dials should run in sync.

To set the DualTime, let me explain with an example:

You are living in Paris - your actually hometime is 14:15 / 2:15 pm
As DualTime you want to see the GMT/UTC time (one hour after Paris: actually 13:15 / 1:15 pm):

 $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  - turn the hands clockwise until the <u>small</u> dial points at  $\mathbf{1}$  o'clock.

2<sup>nd</sup> - then turn the hands against clockwise to 2 o'clock (big hands) - therefore you will see, the <u>small hand</u> from dual time will not move...

3<sup>rd</sup> - turn the hands clockwise again (note the pm/am switching point), until the minute hand points at the actually minute

et voilá - there are two time zones showing by your watch.
